OVR PETS (Pre-Employment **Transition Services)**

- For young adults aged 14-21
- Temporary, 90-hour employment experience
- Employee's wages fully covered by ACRES and OVR -- no cost to your business!
- A trained, professional job coach will be on-site to support the employee at all times during the experience.

OVR Supported Employment

- For adults aged 21+
- Assists job candidate with transitioning into paid employment at your business
- Your new employee receives 40 hours of on-site job coaching to help them successfully transition into your organization, followed by an additional support period to ensure stability and productivity.

What kinds of jobs are good for neurodivergent employees?
